ACCA + 3 month pre-sessional may only commence in Semesters 2 or 4 (pre-sessional course is unconditional entry to main course)

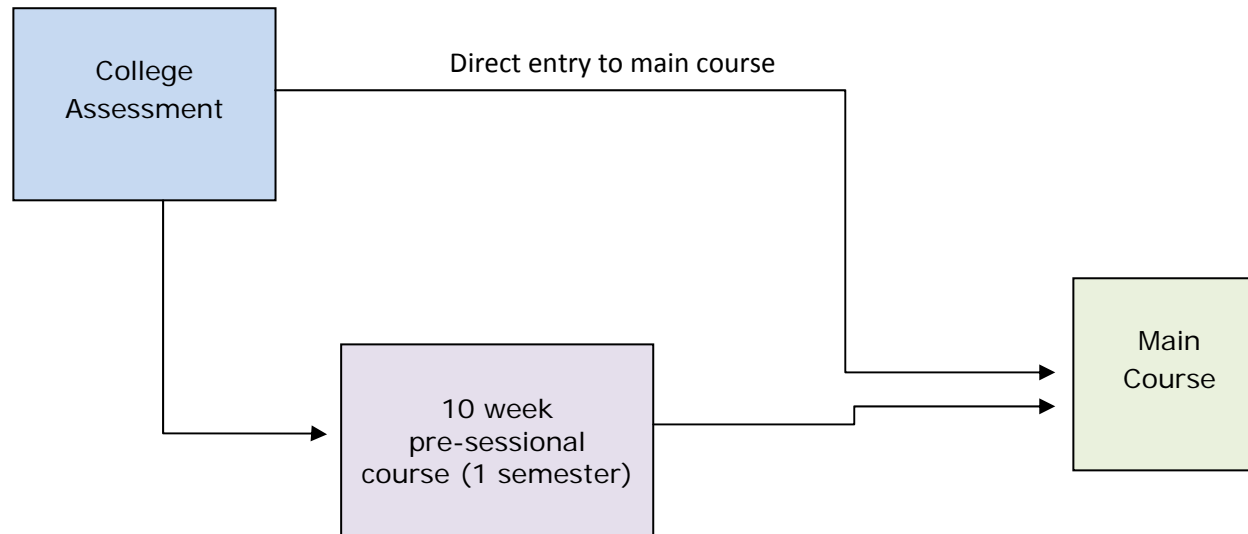

## The Pre-sessional Pathway

At admissions and/or enrolment the college will determine each student's skills/abilities in the following areas:

- English
- Mathematics
- Information Technology
- General Study Skills

Depending on the assessment students may be given entry at three different levels:



Via the Pre-sessional pathway, students are given unconditional entry to their main course. The intention of the Pre-sessional course is to prepare students for their main course. This is achieved by providing English, Mathematics, IT and Study Skill units (Key Academic Skills) to prepare and compliment their selected main course.

Note: Students must still meet the English and Academic entry requirements as set out by the college and/or UKBA. Pre-sessional courses are an additional service provided by the college. Pre-sessional courses are FREE.
